

## Recycling Requirements

**Residents and businesses must separate recyclables from trash.**

**Haulers must collect recyclables separately from trash.**

The Recycling Act, P.L. 1987, c.102, established the statutory framework for mandatory statewide recycling. Municipal ordinances detail the local requirements for separation and set-out of recyclables by residents and businesses.

Pursuant to NJDEP Recycling Rules, N.J.S.A. 13:1E-99.16(d) The governing body of a municipality may exempt persons occupying commercial premises from source separation requirements of the ordinance **if** those persons have otherwise provided for the recycling of designated recyclables. To be eligible for an exemption, a commercial waste generator must receive the prior written approval of the municipality and must annually provide written documentation to the municipality of the total number of tons recycled.

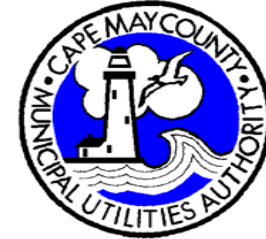

## Appoint a Recycling Coordinator

You or someone in your business:

- should know where to obtain information about recycling;
- should know who to call when recyclables are not picked up on schedule;
- should be responsible for training new employees;
- should report tons recycled to your municipality if your office is not part of the municipal collection program; and
- should know how to recycle other wastes: electronics, paint, batteries and more...

## What to Recycle

### MANDATORY RECYCLABLES

#### Mixed paper including:

- Cardboard
- Office Paper & Brochures
- Newspaper & Magazines
- Bulk Mail & Shredded Paper (shredded paper must be in a clear plastic bag)

#### Cans and Bottles including:

- Glass Bottles
- Plastic Bottles with a ♻️ through ♻️ imprinted on the bottom
- Aluminum Cans
- Steel (tin) Cans

## How to Recycle

### COLLECTION IN YOUR OFFICE

**Paper** is best collected at each work station and periodically moved to a larger storage container by each employee or the cleaning staff. Each work station should have an appropriately sized, well labeled bin at desk side or perhaps box lid as an under desk bin. As listed at left, all kinds of paper and corrugated boxes may be stored in one container. Shredded paper in see-through plastic bags can be added to the storage container. The storage bin (s) can double as the set-out container(s). Consider purchasing a large wheeled container.

**Cans and bottles** may be collected in one or two centrally located containers which may also serve as the set-out containers.

If your office generates more than 6 large (30 gal) containers, consider purchasing or renting a small dumpster.

### COLLECTION FROM YOUR OFFICE

Call your municipality to find out about collection of recyclables. Most municipalities offer free curb-side collection to businesses.

If municipal collection is not an option in your location or not sufficient for your needs, contact a private hauler. Recyclables and trash must be hauled separately.

You can self-haul recyclables to the CMCMUA Transfer Station and Landfill. Cans and Bottles, Paper and Corrugated are accepted FREE.
