- Thinners and Solvents
- Cleaning Products
- Gasoline and Other Flammable Liquids
- Automotive Products
- Pesticides and Herbicides
- Glues/Adhesives
- Photographic Chemicals
- Mercury-Containing Items
- Pool Chemicals
- Fluorescent Blubs



We Can't Accept:

- Unidentified Wastes
- Explosives
- Radioactive Materials
- Aerosol Cans (Aerosol cans are not hazardous and may be disposed of as regular trash, once empty.)
- Paint, Motor Oil, Motor Oil Filters, Anti-freeze (Recycling programs available for Cape May County generators, see below.)
- Waste from Regulated Hazardous Waste Generators



ATTENTION HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE CUSTOMERS

Up to 25 gallons of liquid and/or 100 pounds of dry Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) will be accepted **FREE**. Quantities above 25 gallons and/or 100 pounds will be charged **\$5.00 per gallon/\$5.00 per pound**. Quantity limits are per vehicle, not per customer. **Cape May County generated HHW only**. RECYCLE PAINT, MOTOR OIL, MOTOR OIL FILTERS AND ANTIFREEZE

Oil Based and Water Based Paint is accepted at the CMCMUA Transfer Station in Middle Township during normal operating hours at a fee of **\$1.25 per gallon can, \$6.25 per 5 gallon bucket**. Smaller cans and aerosol cans containing paint are accepted **FREE**.

Motor Oil, Motor Oil Filters and Antifreeze are accepted **FREE** at the CMCMUA Transfer Station and Sanitary Landfill during normal operating hours with a 5 gallon, 5 filter limit per day, per customer.

Directions to the Sanitary Landfill

If traveling either north or south on Route 9: Proceed to the intersection of Route 9 and Route 550 in Ocean View (traffic signal). Turn west onto Route 550 (Woodbine-Ocean View Road) and continue to the intersection of Route 610 (4-way stop). Turn right onto Route 610 (Dennisville-Petersburg Road) and the Sanitary Landfill is one half mile on your left.

If traveling on Route 47: Proceed to the intersection of Route 611 or Route 557. Turn north onto Route 611 or Route 557 and proceed to Route 550. Turn right onto Route 550 (DeHirsch Avenue) and continue to the intersection of Route 610 (4-way stop). Turn left onto Route 610 (Dennisville-Petersburg Road) and the Sanitary Landfill is one half mile on your left.
