### **Landfill Gas Recovery Facility**

In 1998, the CMCMUA developed one of this first full scale beneficial use projects for landfill gas in New Jersey. This facility conditions the collected gas which is then conveyed, via underground pipeline, 1¼ miles to the Woodbine Developmental Center. Up to 1200 cubic feet per minute of landfill gas is available for combustion in the Center’s boilers for both heating and cooling purposes thereby replacing the need to burn over 1 million gallons of No. 4 fuel oil annually.
