RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CONTINUATION OF CONTRACT CHEM-56-21 WITH GEORGE S. COYNE CHEMICAL CO., INC. - FURNISH AND DELIVER DRY POLYMER TO VARIOUS CMCMUA WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITIES PURSUANT TO RESOLUTION NO. 6-22

WHEREAS, on January 19, 2022, the Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority ("CMCMUA"/"Authority") adopted Resolution No. 6-22 awarding George S. Coyne Chemical Co., Inc., Contract CHEM-56-21 – Furnish and Deliver Dry Polymer to Various CMCMUA Wastewater Treatment Facilities ("Contract"); and,

WHEREAS, said Contract contains an option provision which would permit the Authority and George S. Coyne Chemical Co., Inc. to continue the Contract for two (2) additional 12-month renewal options; and,

WHEREAS, the Authority is desirous of executing the second 12-month extension of the Contract with George S. Coyne Chemical Co., Inc. pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-15 and, therefore, the Authority wishes to continue the Contract; and,

WHEREAS, compensation to George S. Coyne Chemical Co., Inc. under the continuation of said Contract authorized by this Resolution will be provided based upon the Unit Price per Pound, as contained on the Proposal page of the Bid submitted by George S. Coyne Chemical Co., Inc. on December 7, 2021 for said Contract, as cumulatively adjusted pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-15, for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$212,295.00; and,

WHEREAS, the Authority's Chief Financial Officer will certify that funds are available prior to authorizing each Purchase Order for said services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority, a body corporate and politic, as follows:

- 1. The provisions of the WHEREAS Clauses set forth above are herein incorporated by reference and made a part hereof.
- 2. The term for Contract CHEM-56-21 is extended through February 2, 2025.
- 3. The total not-to-exceed budget of \$212,295.00 for this extended 12-month term for all services provided by George S. Coyne Chemical Co., Inc. under Contract CHEM-56-21 is based upon the Unit Price per Pound, as contained on the Proposal page of the Bid submitted by George S. Coyne Chemical Co., Inc. on December 7, 2021 for said Contract, as cumulatively adjusted pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-15, subject to Year 2024 and Year 2025 Wastewater Management Program Budget appropriations.
- 4. The Authority's Chief Financial Officer and/or Purchasing Agent are hereby authorized to execute any necessary documents to complete this authorization.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.5(b)2, no amount for Furnish and Deliver Dry Polymer to Various CMCMUA Wastewater Treatment Facilities under CHEM-56-21 shall be chargeable or certified until such time as they are actually ordered or otherwise called for. Prior to authorizing any work under this Contract, a certification of available funds shall be made by the Authority's Chief Financial Officer upon receipt of a properly executed Purchase Order and said certification shall be attached to the file copy of the Purchase Order. Total expenditures under this Contract shall not exceed \$212,295.00.

RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 77-23 ENABLING THE CAPE MAY COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY – SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT IMPLEMENTING AGENCY – RECYCLING ENHANCEMENT ACT – DIRECT RECYCLING GRANT TO COUNTIES

WHEREAS, P.L. 2007, c.311, et seq. provides for the awarding of Recycling Tax Fund Entitlements as Direct Recycling Grants to Counties by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection to designated solid waste management districts to assist them in the preparation, revision and implementation of comprehensive solid waste management and recycling plans; and,

WHEREAS, the Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority ("CMCMUA"/"Authority") authorized the filing of a Recycling Enhancement Act 2022 Spending Plan to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection pursuant to P.L. 2007, c.311, et seq. through Resolution No. 77-23; and,

WHEREAS, the CMCMUA's Recycling Enhancement Act 2022 Spending Plan needs revision; and,

WHEREAS, the CMCMUA desires to submit its revised Recycling Enhancement Act 2022 Spending Plan to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection for such financial assistance to fulfill its responsibilities under the Solid Waste Management Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority:

- 1. That the CMCMUA was designated by the County Board of Commissioners as the implementing agency for solid waste and recycling activities such as the Recycling Enhancement Act Tax Fund County Entitlement Program on December 8, 1987.
- 2. That the CMCMUA does hereby hold the State of New Jersey, and its departments and agencies, harmless from any damages, losses and claims which may arise directly or indirectly from the execution of the Entitlement Program.
- 3. That the CMCMUA hereby accepts the terms and conditions set forth in the Recycling Enhancement Act and the guidelines promulgated under it.
- 4. That a revised Recycling Enhancement Act 2022 Spending Plan be submitted to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection detailing the State of New Jersey's budget share of \$162,000.00 and the CMCMUA's budget share (Grantee Match) of \$119,643.39, for a Project Total of \$281,643.39.
- 5. That the Solid Waste Program Manager, or the Executive Director, of the CMCMUA is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file a revised Recycling Enhancement Act 2022 Spending Plan with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, to provide additional information and furnish such documents as may be required, to execute such contracts as are required, and to act as the authorized correspondent of the CMCMUA.

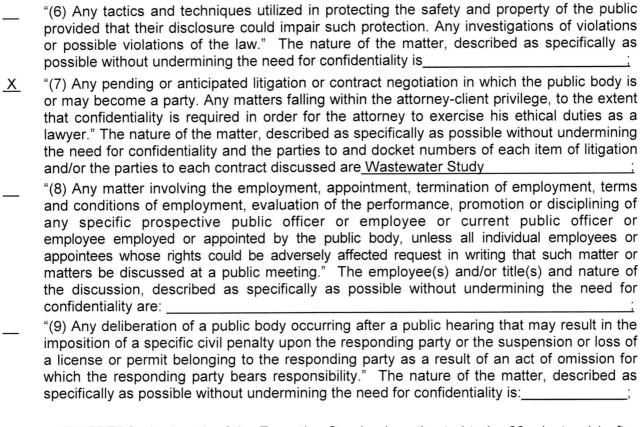
RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTIVE SESSION FROM WHICH THE PUBLIC IS EXCLUDED

WHEREAS, the Open Public Meetings Act (N.J.S.A. 10:4-6 et seq.) requires all meetings of the Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority ("CMCMUA") to be held in public, except as set forth in N.J.S.A. 10:4-12(b) which provides for nine (9) types of matters that may lawfully be discussed in "Executive Session," i.e. without the public being permitted to attend; and,

WHEREAS, the CMCMUA has determined that certain issues set forth below are permitted by N.J.S.A. 10:4-12(b) to be discussed without the public in attendance shall be discussed during an Executive Session to be held on Wednesday, January 17, 2024 at approximately 2:00 p.m.; and,

WHEREAS, the nine (9) exceptions to public meetings set forth in N.J.S.A. 10:4-12(b) are listed below, and the items to be privately discussed that fall within such exceptions shall be identified and written, and after each exception is a space where additional information that will disclose as much information about the discussion as possible without undermining the purpose of the exception as follows:

_	"(1) Any matter which, by express provision of Federal Law, State Statue or Rule of Court shall be render confidential or excluded from public discussion." The legal citation to the provision(s) at issue is: and the nature of the matter, described as specifically as possible without undermining the need for confidentiality is:
_	"(2) Any matter in which the release of information would impair a right to receive funds from the federal government." The nature of the matter, described as specifically as possible without undermining the need for confidentiality is;
_	"(3) Any material the disclosure of which constitutes an unwarranted invasion of individual privacy such as any records, data, reports, recommendations, or other personal material of any educational, training, social service, medical, health, custodial, child protection, rehabilitation, legal defense, welfare, housing, relocation, insurance and similar program or institution operated by a public body pertaining to any specific individual admitted to or served by such institution or program, including but not limited to information relative to the individual's personal and family circumstances, and any material pertaining to admission, discharge, treatment, progress or condition of any individual, unless the individual concerned (or, in the case of a minor or incompetent, his guardian) shall request in writing that the same be disclosed publicly." The nature of the matter, described as specifically as possible without undermining the need for confidentiality is;
	"(4) Any collective bargaining agreement, or the terms and conditions of which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining agreement, including the negotiation of terms and conditions with employees or representatives of employees of the public body." The collective bargaining contract(s) discussed are between the public body and the;
	"(5) Any matter involving the purchase, lease or acquisition of real property with public funds, the setting of bank rates or investment of public funds where it could adversely affect the public interest if discussion of such matters were disclosed." The nature of the matter, described as specifically as possible without undermining the need for confidentiality is;



WHEREAS, the length of the Executive Session is estimated to be 20 minutes (s) after which the public meeting shall (underline one) reconvene and immediately adjourn or reconvene and proceed with business.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the CMCMUA will go into Executive Session for only the above stated reasons.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the CMCMUA hereby declares that its discussion of the aforementioned subject(s) will be made public at a time when the need for confidentiality no longer exists, or the public's interest in disclosure is greater than any privacy or governmental interest being protected from disclosure.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the CMCMUA's General Counsel, shall read aloud enough of this resolution so that members of the public in attendance can understand, as precisely as possible, the nature of the matters that will be privately discussed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the CMCMUA's Corporate Secretary, on the next business day following this meeting, shall furnish a copy of this resolution to any member of the public who requests one at the fees allowed by N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1 et seq.
