WHEREAS, the Public Hearing explaining the nature of the user charges and specific service charges, as set forth in the aforementioned Rate Setting Report, was held by the Authority on October 5, 2022; and,

WHEREAS, a record of the Public Hearing was made and a transcript will be available upon request to interested parties at a reasonable fee.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority, a body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1. The methodology and system of charges as set forth by the Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority in its report entitled "CMCMUA User Charge System, Rate Setting Report, Wastewater Management Program User Charges Effective January 1, 2023 (Proposed)", is hereby found to comply with the terms of the Service Agreement between the Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority and the various Participants and is adopted by the Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority.
- 2. Said system of charges shall be the basis for charging all Participants who deliver wastewater into the Authority's Regional System.

- 3. The user charges set forth in the aforementioned Rate Setting Report, effective January 1, 2023, are specifically adopted and shall be the basis for billing the services provided to the City of Ocean City, the City of Cape May, the Borough of West Cape May, the Borough of Cape May Point, the Borough of Stone Harbor, the Borough of Avalon, the City of Sea Isle City, the Township of Middle, the County of Cape May (Crest Haven Complex), the City of North Wildwood, the City of Wildwood, the Borough of Wildwood Crest, the Borough of West Wildwood, the Township of Lower Municipal Utilities Authority (Shawcrest area of Lower Township), the New Jersey-American Water Company, the New Jersey Turnpike Authority, and any other users of the services provided by the Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority, effective January 1, 2023.
- 4. The specific service charges, including effluent disposal services provided to the Township of Lower Municipal Utilities Authority, and also including surcharges for high strength wastes, specific service charges for disposal of septage, sludge and trucked raw wastewater, and landfill leachate disposal, as shown in the report entitled "CMCMUA User Charge System, Rate Setting Report, Wastewater Management Program User Charges Effective January 1, 2023 (Proposed)", are hereby adopted, effective January 1, 2023.

RESOLUTION OF THE CAPE MAY COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY DESIGNATING OEM REPLACEMENT PARTS FOR THE TR626 TROMMEL SCREEN MANUFACTURED BY VERMEER CORPORATION AS PROPRIETARY GOODS AND SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority ("CMCMUA" and/or "Authority") currently owns and operates a TR626 Trommel Screen manufactured by Vermeer Corporation ("Vermeer"); and,

WHEREAS, in order to properly maintain the Vermeer equipment and ensure its integrity and functionality, the Authority must only utilize Original Equipment Manufacturer ("OEM") replacement parts; and,

WHEREAS, the Authority therefore has a compelling need to specify said parts as proprietary as authorized by N.J.S.A. 40A:11-13(d) and N.J.A.C. 5:34-9.1 et seq., as the proprietary designation overshadows the public benefit of use of "brand name or equivalent"; and,

WHEREAS, in a memorandum to the CMCMUA's Executive Director, dated September 21, 2022, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, the CMCMUA's Solid Waste Program Manager and Qualified Purchasing Agent, on behalf of the Authority, have certified that the Vermeer TR626 Trommel Screen parts are of a specialized nature and necessary for the conduct of the affairs of the CMCMUA and therefore certified that OEM Replacement Parts meet the definition of "Proprietary Goods and Services", as defined in N.J.S.A. 40A:11-2(39); and,

WHEREAS, the Authority's General Legal Counsel has reviewed the memorandum to the CMCMUA's Executive Director, dated September 21, 2022, from the CMCMUA's Solid Waste Program Manager and Qualified Purchasing Agent for the special need for the proprietary goods and has opined, after researching the applicable law, of its applicability and acceptability pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-13(d) and N.J.A.C. 5:34-9.1.

WHEREAS, a copy of this Resolution and the memorandum to the CMCMUA's Executive Director, dated September 21, 2022, from the CMCMUA's Solid Waste Program Manager and Qualified Purchasing Agent certifying OEM Replacement Parts are both specialized and necessary shall be incorporated into the Bid Specifications for the subject product.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority, a body corporate and politic, as follows:

- 1. The provisions of the **WHEREAS** clauses set forth above are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.
- 2. The Authority agrees that due to the specialized nature of the OEM Replacement Parts for the TR626 Trommel Screen manufactured by the Vermeer Corporation, it is necessary for the conduct of its affairs the only acceptable manufacturer for the OEM Replacement Parts is Vermeer Corporation.
- 3. The Authority's Executive Director, or Deputy Director, along with its Qualified Purchasing Agent or Chief Financial Officer, is hereby authorized to issue Bid Specifications which designate Vermeer Corporation OEM Replacement Parts for the TR626 Trommel Screen as "Proprietary Goods and Services" in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:34-9.1 et seq.

RE: Certification for the Purchase of Proprietary Goods: Vermeer Corporation

The Authority currently owns and operates a 718 Compost Turner and a TR626 Trommel Screen, both manufactured by Vermeer Corporation (Vermeer). The Compost Turner was purchased in 2016 and the Trommel Screen was purchased in 2020. Both the Compost Turner and Trommel Screen are used to process recyclable vegetative materials received from residents, commercial landscapers and municipalities at the Class B/C Recycling Center at the Authority's Sanitary Landfill Facility in Woodbine, New Jersey. Leaves and grass that are accepted at the Cass B/C facility are stored in windrows which are required to be turned with the Compost Turner to add oxygen and facilitate the breakdown of the material making the composting process more efficient. Once the compost process is complete, the material is screened using the Trommel Screen to remove material such as rocks, sticks and other debris. The Trommel Screen is also used to screen top soil material. Both the leaf compost and the top soil are used in the production of Terragro, a soil amendment product. Leaf compost, top soil and Terragro products are all sold to residents, landscapers and garden centers in Cape May County. Because both the 718 Compost Turner and the TR626 Trommel Screen are both essential to the success of the Class B/C Recycling Program, the need for Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) replacement parts for this equipment and any future purchases of Vermeer equipment is necessary.

OEM replacement parts for the 718 Compost Turner were designated as proprietary in 2020 with Resolution No. 114-20. In order to maintain the TR626 Trommel Screen and ensure its integrity and functionality, the Authority must utilize OEM replacement parts for the maintenance and repairs of this equipment also. In addition, any OEM parts needed to service Vermeer equipment purchased in the future should also be designated as proprietary. As such, I do hereby certify in accordance with the requirements of N.J.A.C. 5:34-9.1(b) that the above referenced products are specialized in nature and necessary for the conduct and affairs of the Authority and therefore meets the definition of "Proprietary" goods as defined in N.J.A.C. 40A:11-2.

Having therefore determined that the products meet the definition of "Proprietary" in accordance with New Jersey law, I recommend placing a Resolution on the agenda for the upcoming Board Meeting declaring Vermeer OEM parts as Proprietary goods as required and further to develop bidding specifications, as provided in N.J.A.C. 40:11-13(d) to acquire same.

I. INTRODUCTION AND FACTUAL ANALYSIS

Please allow this to serve as a response to your inquiry regarding the Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority's (CMCMUA and/or Authority) purchase of Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) replacement parts through a proprietary bid in a manner consistent with the Local Public Contracts Law for the Authority's Vermeer Corporation ("Vermeer") 718 Compost Turner and TR626 Trommel Screen

The Authority currently owns and operates a 718 Compost Turner and a TR626 Trommel Screen, both manufactured by Vermeer. The Compost Turner and TR626 Trommel Screen both are used for the purpose of processing the recyclable vegetative materials received from residents, commercial landscapers and municipalities at the Class B/C Recycling Center. Because both machines are essential to the success of the Class B/C Recycling Program, the need form OEM replacement parts for this equipment and any future purchases of Vermeer equipment is necessary.

OEM replacement parts for the 718 Compost Turner were designated as proprietary in 2020 via Resolution No. 114-20, and similarly, according to Authority staff, to maintain the TR626 Trommel Screen and ensure its integrity and functionality, the Authority must utilize OEM replacement parts for the maintenance and repairs of this equipment also.

In light of the aforementioned, via memorandum, dated September 21, 2022, Mr. John

Conturo, Solid Waste Program Manager on behalf of the Authority and Mr. Kevin McGahey, Purchasing Agent on behalf of the Authority, certified that the above referenced products are specialized in nature and necessary for the conduct of the affairs of the Authority and therefore certified that OEM Replacement Parts meet the definition of proprietary goods as prescribed by law.

II. LEGAL ANALYSIS

The purchase of proprietary goods is governed by the provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law and the regulatory provisions promulgated pursuant to the enabling legislation. The law generally prohibits specifications from requiring the furnishing of any "brand name" but may in all cases require "brand name or equivalent". However, this does not apply if goods or services to be provided or performed are deemed proprietary. When goods or services are proprietary, they may be purchased by stipulating the proprietary goods or services in the bid specification and specify that the special need for such proprietary goods or services is directly related to the performance, completion or undertaking of the purpose for which the contract is awarded. N.J.S.A. 40A:11-13(d).

The Local Public Contact Law defines the word "proprietary" as "goods or services of a specialized nature, that may be made or marketed by a person or persons having the exclusive right to make or sell them, when the need for such goods or services has been certified in writing by the governing body of the contracting unit to be necessary for the conduct of its affairs." N.J.S.A. 40A:11-2(39). Based upon the memorandum from Mr. Conturo and Mr. McGahey, it is my legal opinion that the OEM replacement parts do meet the definition of "proprietary" in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-2(39)

As the referenced products have been determined to be proprietary, a specific purchasing process must be followed. Prior to advertising for the receipt of bids that includes proprietary goods or services, the contracting agent or purchasing agent shall certify in writing to the chief executive officer of the contracting unit an explanation of why the goods or services are of a specialized nature and necessary for the conduct of the affairs of the local contracting unit. N.J.A.C. 5:34-9.1(b). The memorandum by Mr. Conturo and Mr. McGahey satisfies this regulatory requirement. The memorandum clearly and concisely explains why the OEM replacement parts are both specialized and necessary as required by law. The memorandum must be provided as part of the bid specifications.

Additionally, the Authority is required to pass a resolution authorizing the proprietary nature of the specifications which must include a description of why the goods or services are specialized in nature and necessary for the conduct of the affairs of the contracting unit. N.J.A.C. 5:34-9.1(c)

Prior to authorizing any work under this Contract, a certification of available funds shall be made by the Authority's Chief Financial Officer upon receipt of a properly executed Purchase Order and said certification shall be attached to the file copy of the Purchase Order. Total expenditures under this contract shall not exceed \$110,000.00.
