#### Construction Status Report - May 25, 2022 - Thomas J. LaRocco

New Electrical Systems for Various Pump Stations - This contract consists of the replacement of various pieces of equipment and electrical upgrades to twenty-one (21) pump stations distributed amongst all four of the Authority's Wastewater Regions. Work consists of implementing a complete station bypass before demolishing and replacing key existing electrical and mechanical components including cabling, conduit, transfer switches, louvers, ductwork and grounding systems. All of the stations, except 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, will become equipped with a new exterior docking station that can be used to connect to an emergency portable generator, if necessary, in the future. To date, the following twenty (20) stations are generally complete: Madison (CM), Coral (CM), Claghorn (CM), 69<sup>th</sup> Street (SM/M), 81<sup>st</sup> Street (SM/M), Mayville (SM/M), Stone Harbor Manor (SM/M), Crest Haven (SM/M), 39<sup>th</sup> Street (SM/M), Spicer (WW/L), Neptune (WW/L), Oak (WW/L), Shawcrest (WW/L), Rio Grande (WW/L), 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue (WW/L), Lower Township EDS (WW/L), Rosemary Road (WW/L), 3<sup>rd</sup> Street (OC), 32<sup>nd</sup> Street (OC) and 20<sup>th</sup> Street (OC).

At the Cape May Court House (SM/M) Pump Station, an air flow test was conducted on May 3<sup>rd</sup>. The test was successful. However, while completing the physical work required to be done in the wake of the test, it was determined that one of the existing louvers will need to be replaced. Except for the various test reports that are to be submitted by the Contractor, this is the only actual work item that remains to be done in order to deem this project totally complete.

Landfill #2 Scale House and Transfer Station Docking Stations with Portable Generator - The purpose of this contract is to install emergency docking stations at the Landfill's No. 2 Scale House and at the Solid Waste Transfer Station, as well as to procure a new trailer mounted generator so as to provide power to either facility in the event of a power outage. Start-up and testing of the new portable generator took place at both the Transfer Station and the Landfill's No. 2 Scale House between May 24<sup>th</sup> and May 27<sup>th</sup>. However, during testing it was found that the Automatic Transfer Switches were not compatible with the generators causing a delay in completion of this project.

Sludge Transfer Facility Utility Consolidation – The purpose of this contract is to consolidate and relocate those utilities at the Sludge Transfer Facility that will be required to maintain operations at the Facility during and after the future demolition of several structures at the Facility. Over the past month, the Contractor has been excavating trenches, installing new conduits and electrical distribution manholes, encasing the conduits in concrete for protection, and backfilling the trenches in order to reroute the power for the Facility around its perimeter. This will allow the future disconnection and demolition of the existing power feeds that traverse the interior area of the Facility.

<u>Various Regions Miscellaneous Concrete Work</u> - The purpose of this contract is to complete miscellaneous concrete work that is related to CMCMUA infrastructure in both the Wildwood/Lower and Ocean City service regions. Final pavement restoration on Delaware Avenue had been scheduled to be completed by May 26th. However, in order to accommodate the City's schedule to install an underdrain along the west side of Delaware Avenue, the Contractor shall be granted an extension of time for approximately two weeks to complete final pavement restoration.

#### 1.0 General:

The week of May 9 through 12, 2022 the New Jersey Water Environment Association (NJWEA) held its annual Conference in Atlantic City. 

#### **Construction Contract**

Contract SM-04-21 Seven Mile Region Control System SCADA Upgrade continues with Scalfo Electric. Scalfo is essentially complete with the installation work at the Seven Mile Beach/Middle Wastewater Treatment Facility. Scalfo is now working at Stone Harbor Boulevard and the Crest Haven Pump Stations. At the time of this report these two stations are scheduled for commissioning the week of 6/13/22. 

#### Clarifier Gallery Overhaul at Wildwood/Lower

As part of the Wastewater Program's 20 year Capital Renewal and Replacement Plan, the clarifier gallery is being overhauled in order to provide operational efficiency in the control of primary and secondary sludge pumps. This project includes installing new VFDs, new valves, rebuilt pumps and rebuilt motors for both primary and secondary clarifiers. The mechanical and operation staff have identified the necessary valves for replacement and have placed material orders. Electrical staff have mounted six (6) new VFDs (three (3) for primary clarifiers and three (3) for secondary clarifiers) and have begun running control/power wiring. They have successfully operated the six (6) VFD installations using the new control system. The material to install an additional six (6) VFDs (three (3) for primary clarifiers and three (3) for secondary clarifiers) has been ordered. The project is on hold until the delivery of materials.

# Replacement of Rotating Biological Contactors (RBCs) at Cape May and Ocean City and Refurbishment of Rotating Biological Reactors (RBR) at Ocean City

As part of the Wastewater Program's 20 year Capital Renewal and Replacement Plan, four (4) RBCs are being replaced at the Cape May WTF which will complete all of the RBC replacements necessary at the plant. At the Ocean City WTF, three (3) RBCs are scheduled to be replaced and one (1) Rotating Biological Reactor (RBR) will be rehabilitated.

At Cape May, the electrical upgrades for the RBCs are complete. The RBCs have been installed and start-up was completed.

At the Ocean City Wastewater Treatment Facility, the RBCs have been installed and start-up was completed. The RBR was also installed and has begun seeding in preparation for the July 4th weekend. See pictures below on the day of installation. (Please see pictures below and on the following page.)








# Replace Component Parts for Clarifiers at the Seven Mile Beach/Middle and Wildwood Lower

As part of the Wastewater Program's 20 year Capital Renewal and Replacement Plan, the component parts of one (1) primary and one (1) secondary clarifier are being replaced at the Seven Mile Beach/Middle WTF. In addition, the component parts of two (2) secondary clarifiers are being replaced at the Wildwood/Lower WTF.

At Seven Mile Beach/Middle WTF, the replacement parts for the secondary clarifier have been installed and start-up was completed. The primary clarifier is scheduled to be completed in the middle of June.



At Wildwood/Lower WTF, plant staff completed the removal of the existing component parts of both secondary clarifiers. Replacement of the parts is scheduled for summer.

#### Replace Pumps, Motors, and Valving at Spicer Avenue Pump Station

As part of the Wastewater Program's 20 year Capital Renewal and Replacement Plan, this pump station was identified as requiring upgrades. Engineering was completed in-house and the pump station was redesigned to operate more efficiently. The re-design consists of two large pumps (each pump is capable of pumping peak summer flows) and two small pumps (each pump is capable of pumping peak winter flows) all on VFDs. The small pumps will provide pumping for approximately 90% of the year because even during the summer, they are capable of pumping during non-peak flow times. Being able to use the small pumps to this extent is a huge cost savings, as the small pumps are run by a 40 horsepower motor while the large pumps are run by a 125 horsepower motor. Cost savings are amplified further as the VFD allows the pump to operate at its peak performance even with different flows.

The pumps, motors, and valving at Spicer Avenue Pump Station are being replaced by the Project Crew. This project will be completed in two phases. The first phase does not require a bypass and is being completed prior to summer. The second phase requires a bypass and will be completed in the fall.

Currently, the Project Crew has installed and successfully completed start up for one of the small pumps, motor, valving, and piping. One (1) of the two (2) new jib cranes which allows maintenance to be completed on the newly installed pumps/motors/valves has been installed. The project crew has begun the installation of the first large pump. They are scheduled to be complete prior to the July 4th weekend.



# Air Release Chamber Evaluations and Air Release Replacements throughout the Authority's Force Main System

As part of the Wastewater Program's 20-Year Capital Renewal and Replacement Program, the replacement of air release chamber components that have either failed or reached their end of life are being replaced. Air Release Valves provide an important function to forcemains. An Air Release Valve allows air to escape a forcemain when water fills the pipe under higher pressure so air does not become entrapped and restrict the flow of water. When flows reduce to the point where there is air space in the pipe, the air release opens to allow air to fill the empty parts of the forcemain so a vacuum does not occur. If a vacuum were to occur, the forcemain could collapse or at least restrict the flow of the water in the forcemain.

An air release/collection system team has been developed to evaluate all of the air releases in the Authority. The team consists of staff from each plant and is being supervised by Ed Pisani, Wastewater Forman, Cape May. The team is gathered once every 2-weeks and they evaluate air releases to determine which parts need to be replaced (air releases, valving, piping). Currently this team has evaluated all the air releases in the Cape May Region, the air releases along Avalon Boulevard in the Seven Mile Region, and has completed the evaluation of 90% of Wildwood Region (see picture below). Due to the forthcoming traffic, these evaluations are on hold until Fall as well as the installation of replacement parts.



#### 3.2 Repair and Maintenance Projects

#### Process Air Blower Installation at Ocean City

Plant staff reinstalled a rebuilt process air blower using the Authority's laser alignment tool. The laser alignment tool allows staff to install the bearings to the manufacturer's tolerance which in this case were five thousands of an inch (0.005"). Proper installation reduces the wear that the motor, blower, and coupling experience, which leads to less maintenance over time.



#### **RBC** Refurbishments at Wildwood

Plant staff has completed refurbishments to eleven (11) of the sixteen (16) RBC bays to be prepared for summer flows which includes bearing replacements, gearbox rebuilds/replacements, shaft repairs, and rewiring from the MCC bucket to the bay. Below is a picture of a shaft repair. (Please see pictures on the following page.)

WHEREAS, the CMCMUA has the need to purchase goods or services on a timely basis utilizing State Contracts and Cooperative Contracts; and,

WHEREAS, the Authority, by Resolution No. 13-22, dated February 2, 2022 and by Resolution No. 30-22, dated March 16, 2022 authorized its Qualified Purchasing Agent to purchase supplies, services and equipment in excess of the bid threshold from a list of State Contract and Cooperative Contract vendors during 2022; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority, that the CMCMUA hereby authorizes its Qualified Purchasing Agent to purchase the items or services as listed on Attachment A, a copy of which is attached hereto and made part thereof, from the approved New Jersey State and Cooperative Contract vendors whenever it is deemed to be in the Authority's best interests, pursuant to all applicable provisions of their individual State and Cooperative Contracts.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, pursuant to the rules of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey, that no amount of these contracts shall be chargeable or certified until such time as materials, supplies, equipment, or services are ordered, or otherwise called for, prior to placing the order. A certification of available funds shall be made by the Authority's Chief Financial Officer upon receipt of a properly executed Purchase Order and said certification shall be attached to the file copy of the Purchase Order.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this authorization shall terminate on December 31, 2022, or as long as the vendors listed on Attachment A are under a current, or reauthorized, State and Cooperative Contract, whichever event first occurs.

WHEREAS, DTE Energy Trading, Inc., submitted the highest bid of \$11.77 per REC for the purchase of all RECs, during the February 4, 2021 online auction, to be generated during the stated time period; and,

**WHEREAS,** an Agreement for the sale of RECs was executed by the Authority and DTE Energy Trading, Inc., pursuant to Resolution 8-21; and,

WHEREAS, the Authority has generated 42 RECs in April 2022 from the three (3) active electrical generators and 4 RECs from the parasitic electric usage for a total of 46 RECs currently available for sale.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Cape May County Municipal Utilities Authority, a body corporate and politic, as follows:

- 1. The provisions of the WHEREAS clauses set forth above are herein incorporated by reference and made a part hereof.

On February 4, 2021, Marex Spectron, on behalf of the Authority, auctioned Renewable Energy Certificates (REC's) for future generation from June 1, 2021 through May 31, 2023 which will be generated from the three (3) active electrical generators. All REC's were sold for \$11.77 each as:

NJ Class I 2020 REC's: 10,000 firm/2,500 contingent NJ Class I 2021 REC's: 10,000 firm/2,500 contingent

424 REC's were sold for the month of March 2022.

As a continuation of our previous approval process, authorization is requested to sell the current April 2022 REC's totaling 42 REC's as well as 4 REC's generated from the parasitic electric usage all at the \$11.77/REC pricing. Each month, staff will continue to put forward an authorization request as new REC's become available for sale by PJM.
